DIETARY INSTRUCTIONS:

- FOR A MORNING PROCEDURE, DO NOT EAT OR DRINK ANYTHING AFTER MIDNIGHT.
- FOR AN <u>AFTERNOON</u> PROCEDURE, YOU MAY HAVE A CLEAR LIQUID BREAKFAST, THEN <u>NOTHING</u> BY MOUTH, INCLUDING WATER, FIVE HOURS BEFORE YOUR PROCEDURE TIME.

Clear liquids include: water, black tea/coffee, apple juice, broth-chicken, beef or vegetable, white cranberry juice, white grape juice, 7up, ginger ale, Sprite, Mountain Dew, colas, jell-o, Gatorade, popsicles. **Avoid anything with red coloring.**

You must have someone drive you home after the procedure. If the person driving you does not remain at the hospital, they must be within a 15 minute distance and the nurse will notify them when you are almost ready to leave. YOU ARE NOT ALLOWED TO TAKE A TAXI, BUS OR WALK HOME. IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A RIDE, YOUR PROCEDURE WILL BE CANCELED. You will be asked not to drive for 12 hours after the sedation. Most people feel tired after being sedated so rest is recommended. You may resume regular activity the next day.

After your insurance is processed, you will receive a bill for **facility** charges and a bill from Front Range Gastroenterology for **physician** charges. If you have a biopsy, you will receive a bill from the lab where the work was done and from any pathologist involved.
